Presenter Bios

Janice Howman, PT, DPT, MED is the Director of Clinical Education for Ohio University's Physical Therapy program. She is the current Chair of ACAPT's National Consortium of Clinical Educators (NCCE). She has been a PT for over 30 years, practicing clinically as a pediatric PT and serving clinical education in a variety of roles over the years (CI, SCCE, PTA program ACCE and PT program DCE). Janice is an APTA Credentialed Clinical Instructor and has been a Trainer for the Credentialing Program since 1997. She has led the NCCE in developing and implementing their Regional Consortia Networking sessions at the Education Leadership Conference (ELC) since their inception in 2016. Her ser vice and scholarly interests include investigating and strengthening the academic -clinical partnership and building a more interconnected regional and national network for PT clinical educators.

Jamie Bayliss, PT, DHSc serves as the Director of Clinical Education and is an Associate Professor in the Physical Therapy program at Mount St. Joseph University. She serves the clinical community as the co-chair of the Ohio Kentucky Consortium of Physical Therapy Programs. She has been involved in clinical education for nearly 15 years, having served as a credentialed CI (through the APTA) and CCCE prior to her current role in academia. She is an engaged member in the APTA, as well as the Ohio-Kentucky Consortium of Physical Therapy Education, where she served two terms as secretary and currently as co-chair. Dr. Bayliss is a member of the APTA, OPTA, the education and orthopedic sections, the CE special interest group, and the National Consortium of Clinical Educators (NCCE), having previously served in the role of secretary.

Matt Calendrillo PT, DPT, BOCOP is founder and owner of LIVE EVERY DAY, a Physical Therapy, Orthotic, Prosthetic practice throughout northern Connecticut and an oncampus teaching clinic at Springfield College. The on-campus clinic at Springfield College is a natural extension from the classroom to dynamic clinical education opportunities utilizing expert clinicians, faculty members, residents and students. The on-campus clinic, as well as all of his practice locations, create prime opportunities for layers of learning among all levels of clinicians. These layers are fostered in part by a robust Orthopedic Residency Program, and a candidacy status Neurology Residency Program. Further, Matt previously served as the Vice Chair for the National Consortium of Clinical Educators (NCCE).
